This award is available to anyone, any age, enrolled in the dairy project. Completed application must be turned in with your Record Book to the Extension Office.

APPLICATION

Since 1998, the Chaves County 4-H Council has presented the Patrick Pirtle Dairy Memorial Award to the top Chaves County 4-Her in the Dairy Project. In honor of Patrick Pirtle, an outstanding young man that loved being in 4-H and participating in the Dairy Project, a plaque will be presented, and the 4-Her's name will be engraved on a plague or trophy that hangs in the Extension Office.

The Award is based on: Record Book; exhibit achievements; cooperation with County Agents, Fair Officials, 4-H Leaders; Showmanship abilities; overall Leadership in the Club, community, State and other 4-H work.

The application and record book must be submitted together. There is a total score of 100 points possible which will be determined as follows:

Record Book – 40 points Showing Achievement – 5 points Cooperation – 15 points

Showmanship – 15 points Leadership – 15 points Love of Dairy Cattle - 10 points
