Chaves County 4-H Council Officer Duties

President – Preside at Council meetings

Vice-President – Preside at Council meetings in the absence of the president.

Secretary – Keep accurate minutes of the Council meetings and take care of all correspondence.

Treasurer – Keep an accurate record of all funds.

Reporter – Publicize Council activities and compile a scrapbook which records Council activities for the year.

Recreation Leader – Lead the American and 4-H Pledges at all Council Meetings and conduct other recreational activities at the meetings and other events.

Parliamentarian – Be familiar with parliamentary procedure and see that meetings are conducted in a democratic manner.

State Council Representatives – Act as Chaves County’s voting delegates at State 4-H Conference in Las Cruces, NM, in July.
